This past week, there have been two very large marches in Washington D.C. We don't have any official numbers for the marches due to National Park Service not being allowed to tally the numbers from controversy over the "Million-man March" that was not quite a million people. This is a great week to support women and families throughout the nation. The women's march close to the inauguration was a great opportunity to highlight women's needs, but it

also drew attention to the other pro-women, pro-family, and pro-life march that has been happening every year since 1973. In case you missed the news here are some updates:

When questioned about the women's march, President Trump replied: "You're going to have a lot of people coming on Friday. And I will say this, and I didn't realize this. But I was told. President Trump tweeted: "The #MarchForLife is so important. To all of you marching --- you have my full support!"

On Monday, President Trump reinstated the ban on funding non-governmental groups that provide abortions.
