

A Message from Father David



"Our battle is not against flesh and blood" Eph: 6:12

Why is Pro-Life movement important? Why is President Trump's appointment of Neil Gorsuch significant? Why do we cheer for Vice-President Pence when he speaks at the March for life? Why do we chant "Viva Christo Rey" with the crowd even when we do not speak Spanish?

You might think you know the answer to these questions, but do not think too small. Our battle is not against a political party, or against a definition of law, or against an organization. No, our battle is not against flesh and blood as Ephesians 6 says, but rather against spiritual powers, spiritual principalities and powers, against fallen angels who want to make this world selfish and dull place (because the two go together). These are all steps in a war for souls, for life, for the hearts and mind of all to be converted to Jesus Christ.

And how do we win that war? That's exactly what we do at St. Pius X and at every Catholic Church throughout the world. The Lord calls us to conversion - through the SEEK conference, through KCCSC, through men's retreats, through Bible Studies, candle-lit Masses and mission trips. Our own Holy Father was part of the Jesuits - they are the experts in this field. Every one of the Jesuits goes on a 33 day silent retreat. Why? Because our battle is not against flesh and blood. Jesus Christ has won this war, he only asks for our hearts to be united with Him, to be converted, to do His will. ¡Viva Christo Rey!
