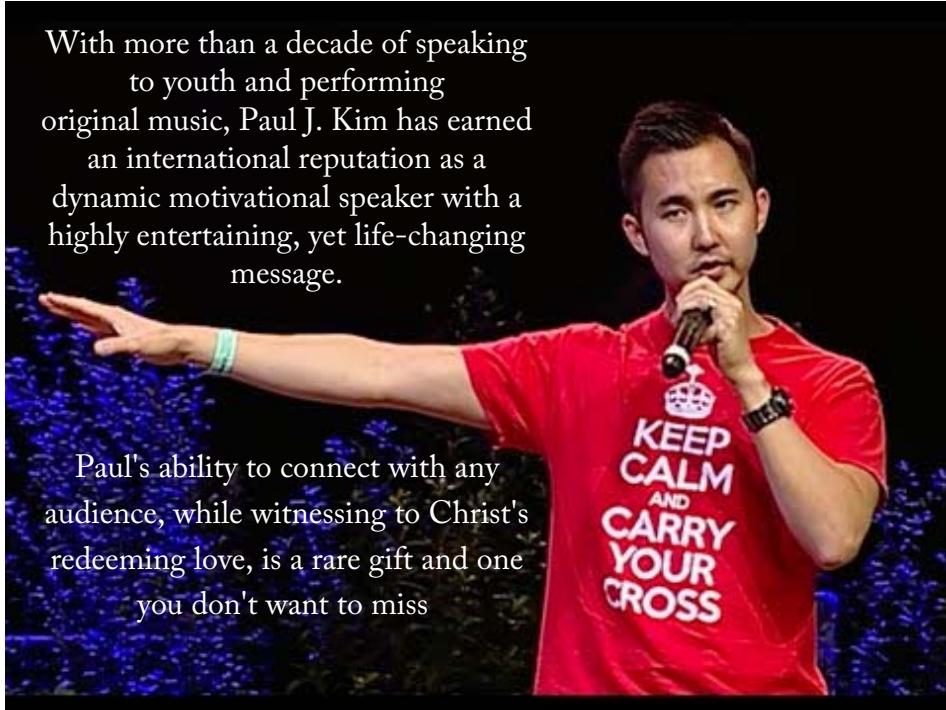


**PAUL J. KIM** SINGER / SPEAKER / INSPIRER

## A Message from Father David

### Lenten Challenge of the Week TRIDUUM!

The Triduum (yes there are suppose to be two "u's" in a row), are the three seemingly separate services of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. They are the most solemn and most interesting liturgies of our entire Church calendar. The liturgies were restructured before the Second Vatican Council in an effort to promote liturgical reform in the entire Church. Because of the early nature of the reforms, the liturgies preserve much of the solemn character of the older rites of the Church. There is a Eucharistic procession, reading of the Passion of St. John, prostration in front of the altar, washing of the feet, a giant bonfire and candle ceremony, dramatic lighting, and veneration of the cross. The three services are actually part of 1 continuous Triduum, so the best challenge is to go to all three as part of your devotion for the end of the Lenten season.

The more personal challenge for those three days is to take fasting very seriously. One tradition is to have a solemn fast from the Mass of the Lord's supper

(Thursday evening) until after the Easter Vigil (usually ends by 10:30 pm on Saturday). The solemn fast would be only taking water. That being said, if you have to drive long distances, operate heavy machinery, or are diabetic, please do not do this. I mention the solemnity of the fast so you can maybe place something else more solemn in its place as well; such as no TV, phone or radio, prayer hours, extra service work, giving money away, very small meals or skipping a meal. The days are different, so our lives should be different as well.



Pray well, and do not be afraid to dive deeply into the Lord's passion, the evidence of His amazing love for you.
