Happy Labor Day to everyone! Here is a great reflection from G.K. Chesterton on labor, God, and how in the Trinity we see the example of the dignity of work.

“And well may God with the
serving-folk
Cast in His dreadful lot;
Is not He too a servant,
And is not He forgot?”

“For was not God my gardener
And silent like a slave;
That opened oaks on the uplands
Or thicket in graveyard gave?”

“And was not God my armourer,
All patient and unpaid,
That sealed my skull as a helmet,
And ribs for hauberk made?”

“Did not a great grey servant
Of all my sires and me,
Build this pavilion of the pines,
And herd the fowls and fill the vines,
And labour and pass and leave no signs
Save mercy and mystery

“For God is a great servant,
And rose before the day,
From some primordial slumber torn;
But all we living later born
Sleep on, and rise after the morn,
And the Lord has gone away.

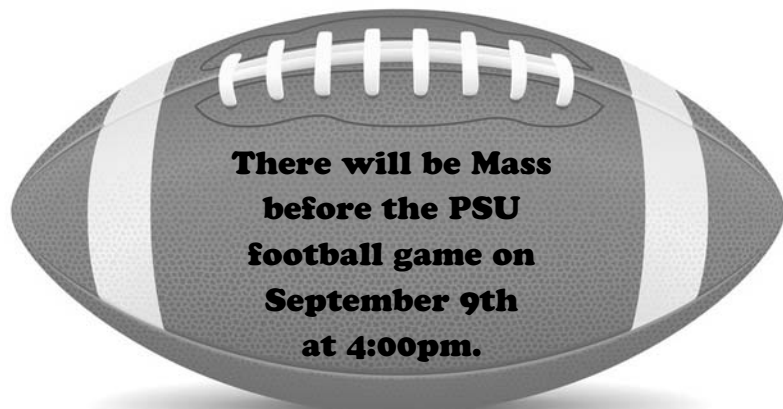
“On things half sprung from sleeping,
