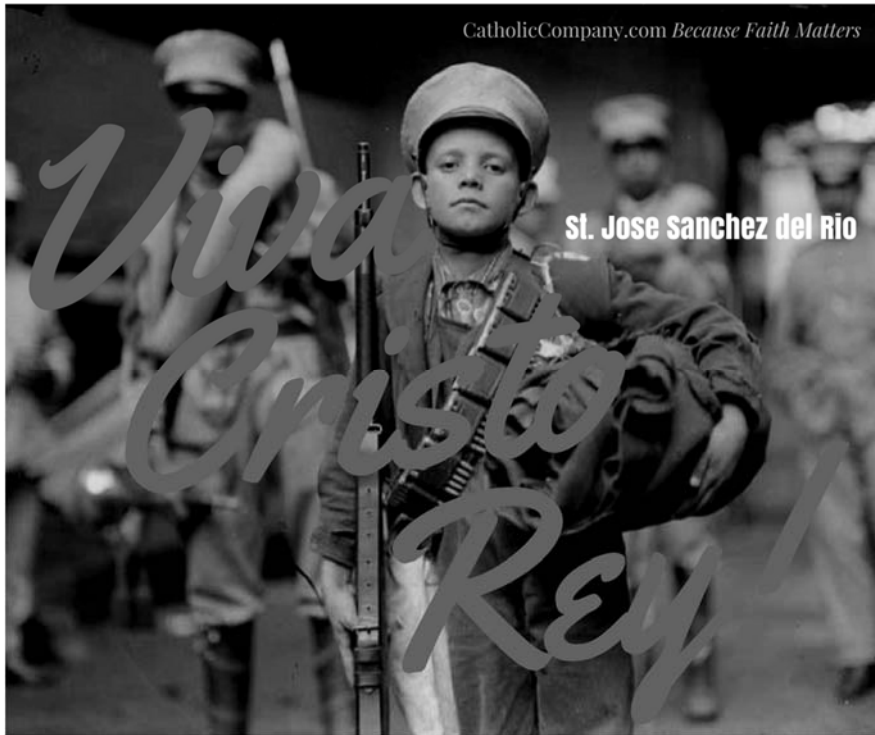

Happy liturgical new year! Every year, the liturgical cycle restarts not in January, but at the first week of Advent. The Sunday before is Christ the King Sunday. Christ the King Sunday was instituted in the 20th century because of the unnerving number of atheistic governments that were all warring with each other. The Church wanted to emphasize that, despite the various powers competing for dominance in the world, Christ has always been our king.

In Mexico, in the 1920s, the atheistic and Masonic government decided to close all Catholic schools and Churches and not allow priests to perform the Sacraments. Many heroic individuals came from these troubled times - names like Bl. Miguel Pro and St. Jose Sanchez del Rio. The martyr's rallying cry was the constant, "Viva Christo Rey!, que viva!" That is, "Long live Christ the King, may He live!"

No matter what happens in our lives, Christ is always our King!
