Message from Fr. David

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat.

GOD SQUAD

Trying to figure out what to do for Lent this year?

We are going to start God Squad here at SPX. God Squad is a Lent long challenge to help us sacrifice and grow closer to the Lord. It is a truly amazing experience and a great sacrifice during this season of Lent.
