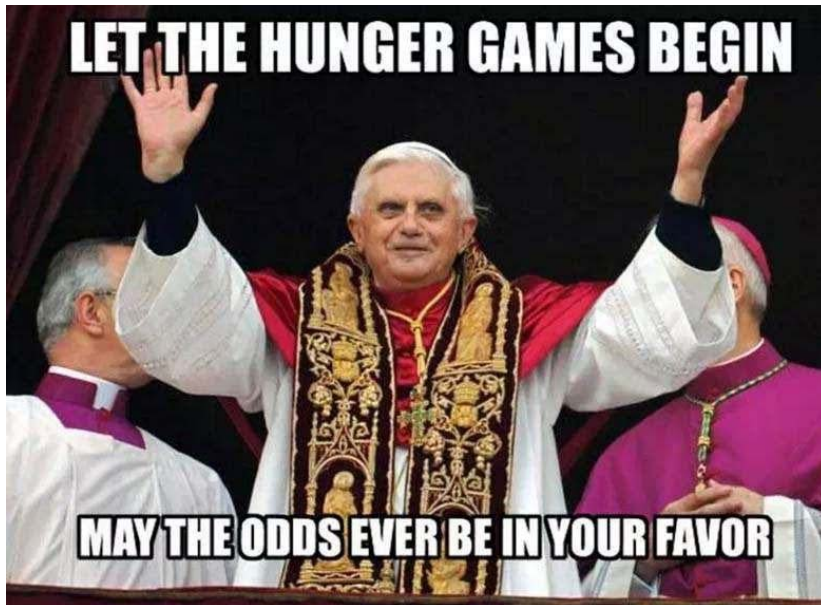

"We can learn something from the Mormons

One of their customs I love, however, is the monthly fast. Once a month, they have 'Fast Sunday'. That day, they are encouraged as a group to go without food or water for 2 whole meals. Then, they are asked to take the money they would have spent on those 2 meals and give that money to the poor! Who would have thought, fasting and almsgiving are linked together!

Actually, the Christian tradition has a long history of linking fasting and almsgiving, we tend to forget our history though. So, if you gave up going out to eat for Lent, that's not just a way to save money - that's money that belongs to the poor. If you gave up desert, all those late night ice cream runs belong to the poor. If you gave up your latte's, those \$6 drinks now belong to the poor.

Every time we give up what seems to be the most valuable to us - like food or money - we find we are able to more trust in God.
