Annunciation!

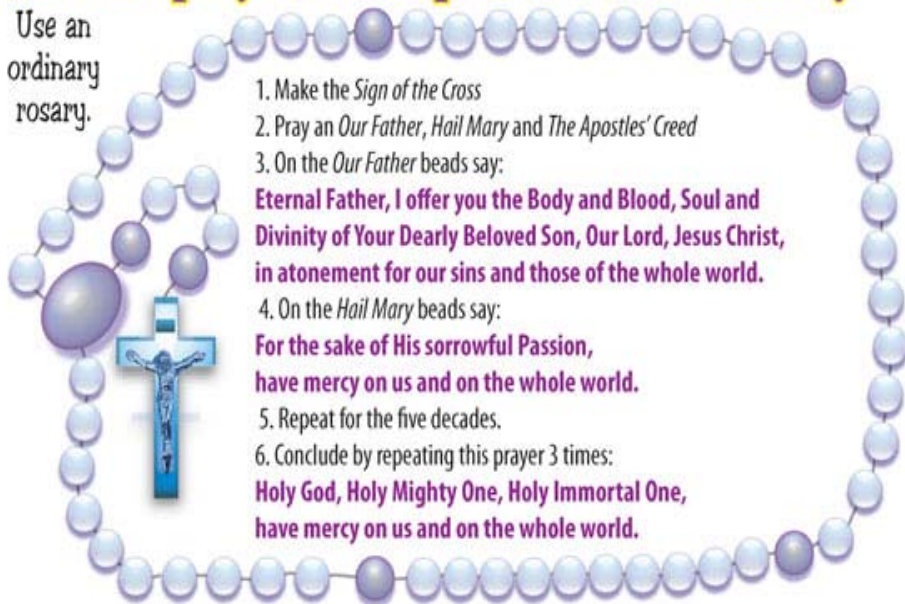
The feast of the Annunciation is normally March 25th. You may ask, why March 25th? Well, the Annunciation is when Jesus was conceived immaculately in Mary's womb ... 9 months from March 25th?

March 25th, however, was Palm Sunday, then there was Holy Week, then there was the Octave of Easter. So, the feast is transferred to the Monday after the Octave of Easter which is April 9th. That's way too complicated. For us, that means we can celebrate that beautiful passage from Luke 1: Fiat voluntas tua, let it be done unto me according to your word. Let us pray that we may always have that open heart to do the Lord's will, always.

Sunday is also Divine Mercy Sunday. This would be a great week to learn the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and pray it at 3 pm every day.

How to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Use an ordinary rosary.



1. Make the *Sign of the Cross*
2. Pray an *Our Father*, *Hail Mary* and *The Apostles' Creed*
3. On the *Our Father* beads say:
Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
4. On the *Hail Mary* beads say:
For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
5. Repeat for the five decades.
6. Conclude by repeating this prayer 3 times:
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
