Students' Prayer by St. Thomas Aquinas

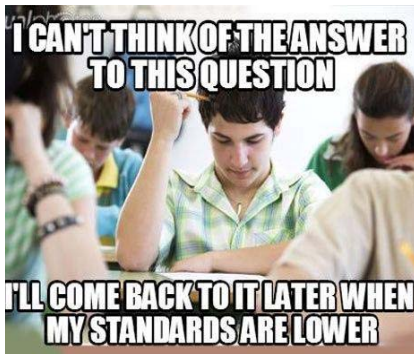

Here is a Novena prayer for Our Lady:

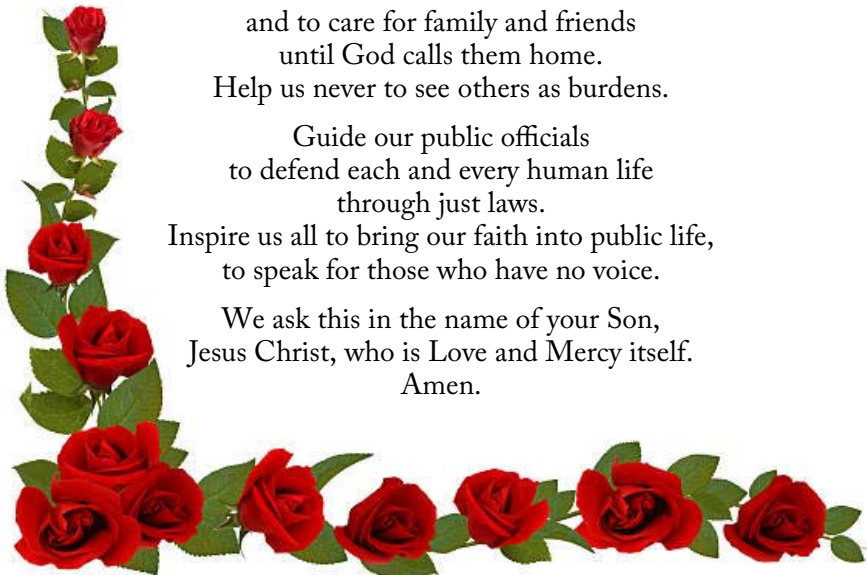
Virgin of Guadalupe,
