

In his letter to the Corinthians, Paul reminds us that we don't have to be a "hand" in order to belong to the body... "there are many parts, yet one body." Therefore, it is not possible for the body to disregard one of its members, nor is it possible for one of the members to deny belonging to the body. Instead, we must help one another discover our talents. We must encourage one another and be grateful for one another. "If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy."
