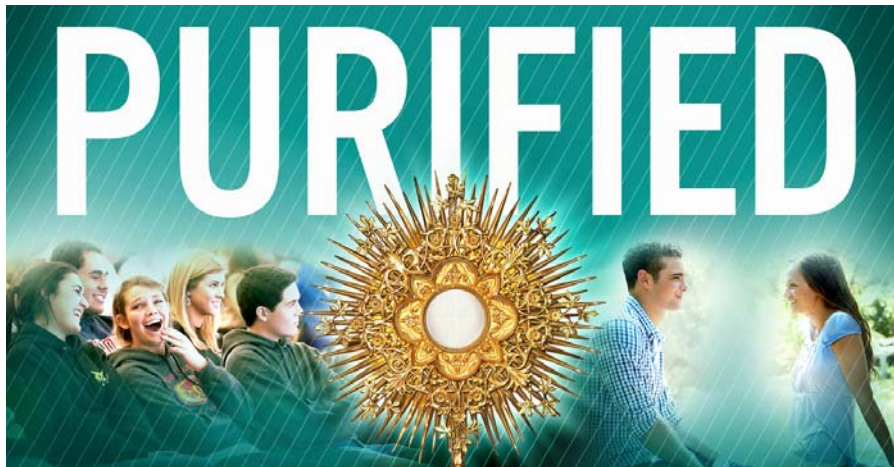

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's gospel offers us an important lesson in hospitality, the first pillar of Stewardship. In this passage, Jesus is "received" by His own people in His own town at first warmly, but then rejected with violence. The people were so familiar with Jesus, they could not accept that He and His words from God. We are left asking ourselves this question: do I receive Jesus hospitably, or am I also guilty of placing expectations on Him? Is my reception of Him self-centered and self-serving? Have I ever rejected Him when I did not



get the response I was seeking? And remember -- our discipleship also calls us to act with hospitality toward one another. As we reflect on our acceptance of Jesus, we can also reflect on our acceptance of one another, keeping in mind that "whatever you do for the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Do we see the Lord "fully alive" in them?
