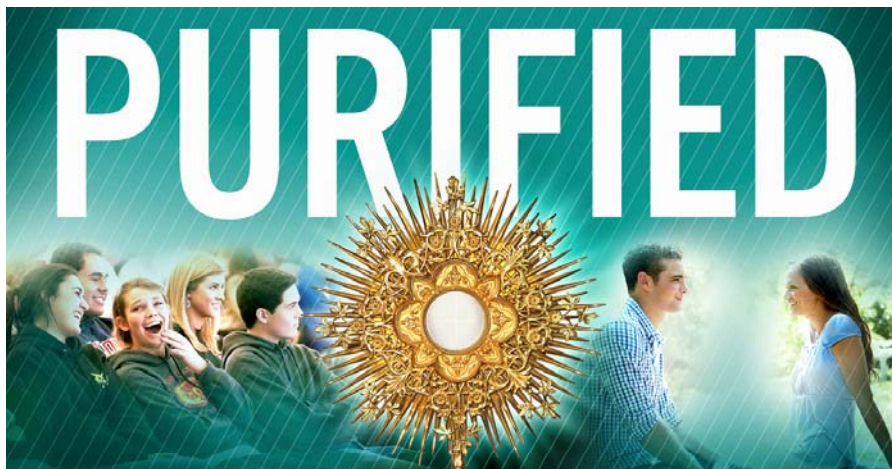

or spirit of those suffering, especially, N.

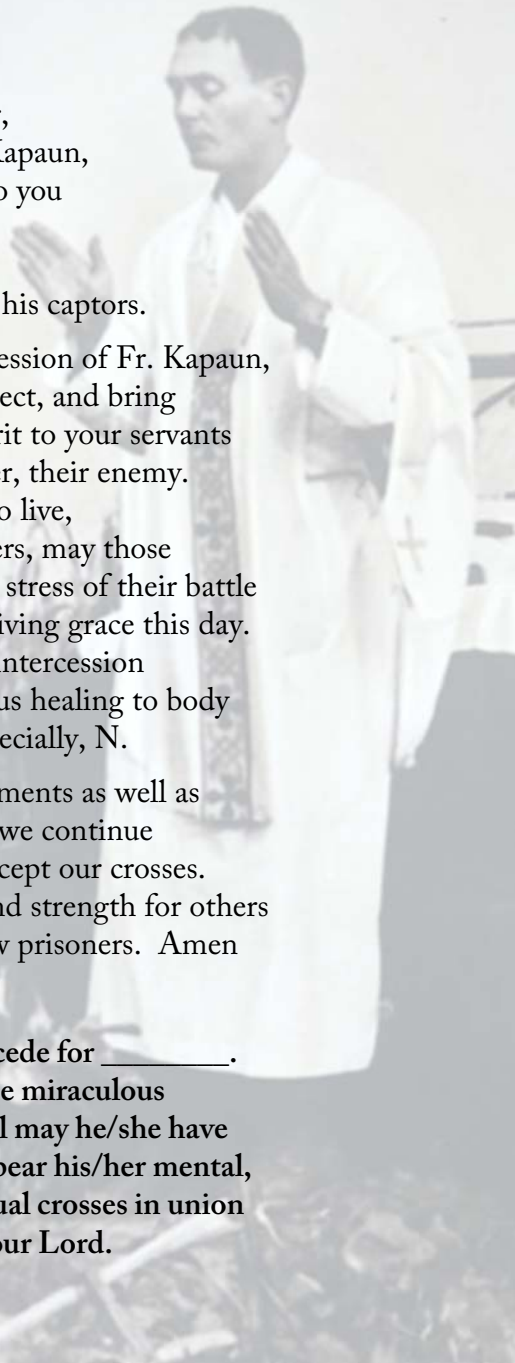
And Lord, in our peaceful moments as well as

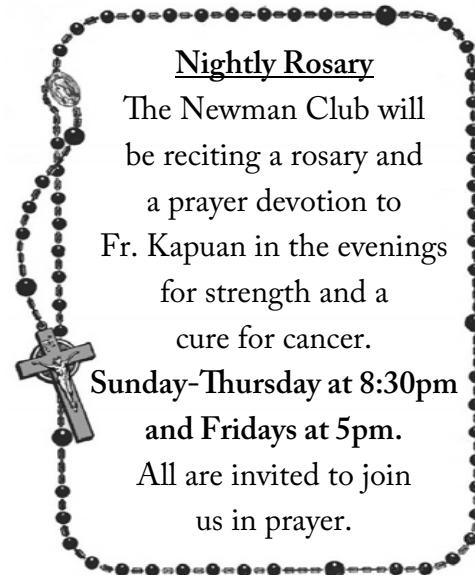
