WHAT IS SAFE HAVEN SUNDAY?

Inspired by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' formal statement Create in Me a Clean Heart: A Pastoral Response to Pornography, Safe Haven Sunday is a weekend set aside within the liturgical calendar by dioceses and parishes to directly address the societal harms of pornography. Within the context of the Mass, parishes are able to provide teaching and resources that will support and protect individuals, marriages, and families in making all homes a safe haven.

WHAT IS FILTERING SOFTWARE?

One of the best first steps we can make to combating pornography in our own lives, or if you have a family, in your household, is by having filtering software that spans all devices. Basic ways of doing this is through parental controls on the phones and streaming services. If you're a college student, you can have a friend or your priest be "your parent" and keep the password for you.

Covenant Eyes is an organization that has more developed filtering software that works on all devices, computers, tablets, and phones. The best part (or most nerve racking part) is that you participate in the software with a friend. So you have an accountability person who helps you get better and receives notifications if there are any lapses in internet usage.

If you would like to use Covenant Eyes, please look up their website or come talk to me (Fr. David). I have ways of helping to pay for it for the college students and to keep it more anonymous as well.
