Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples

Fifth Sunday of Lent

Is 43:16-21 / Phil 3:8-14 / Jn 8:1-11

The idea of being FULLY ALIVE seems to indicate a need for intentional living on our part, and that, indeed, would be true; however, it would not be enough. Even with 100% of our own good intentions, we would still require a second ingredient: the grace of God. We become

FULLY alive because we are filled with God's grace. You only need to

look at today's readings to have proof. The prophet Isaiah refers to the LORD as the one who rescued the Jewish people from slavery; He opened a way in the sea and a path in the waters. In other words, He made it possible for them to survive. But to



survive is not the same as living -- they are ALIVE because God was with them and God was within them. They were His people, and they were filled with His grace. Then, in John's gospel, we have the woman who was to be put to death for her sin of adultery. When Jesus pointed out that each of the men gathered there was also a sinner, they departed; they let her live. Jesus recognized that she needed more. He poured out His grace and forgave her, allowing her to become FULLY alive in His love. Carry this message with you as you make your way through this week. As stewards of God's gifts, we should live and give purposefully, but we must remember that it is only through God's grace that we can become FULLY ALIVE.
